

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe utilizes P.L. 93-638 funds for purposes of governmental improvement, including, as primary function, Tribal planning for the development of the White Mountain Apache Reservation; and

WHEREAS, a basic requirement for sound planning is the accumulation, analysis and evaluation of an extensive data base describing the natural human and financial resources of the Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the tasks involved in resource data accumulation, analysis and evaluation require the services of a trained, specialized Planner Analyst; and


WHEREAS, funds are available through the Federal Office of Personnel Management (OPM) up to \$15,000 for internship training in the skills required for the Planner Analyst position; the balance (approximately \$10,000) for funding the position to be provided from Tribal or other source.

BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council hereby approves the allocation of \$10,000 from FY 1983 BIA PL 93-638 Governmental Improvement Funding for the Planner Analyst position required in the Apache Planning Office; said funding to be obtained by reductions in other PL 93-638 requests for FY 1983.

The foregoing resolution was on July 9, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
