

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Health Authority has been without a permanent Director since Ms. Carla Baha Alchesay was appointed as the Director of the Indian Health Service Hospital several months ago, and

WHEREAS, the Authority's Board of Directors for the Health Authority has recommended that Mrs. Ruth Wilson be hired as the new permanent Director for the Health Authority, and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Ruth Wilson has presented herself before the Tribal Council and the Tribal Council has interviewed her and asked her appropriate questions regarding her background and goals for the position, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the recommendation of the Board of Directors of the Tribal Health Authority that Mrs. Ruth Wilson be appointed permanently to the position of Director of the Health Authority is well taken.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby confirms the appointment of Mrs. Ruth Wilson as the Health Authority Director immediately.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it welcomes Mrs. Ruth Wilson onto the reservation and wishes her well in her new position.

The foregoing resolution was on August 10, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i & s) of the Amended Tribal Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
