

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Roads Department has requested permission from the Tribal Council to make a bid on the Black River Bridge repair projects and to do the blacktopping for that project, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the Roads Department should have the opportunity to make its bid for the Black River bridge repair.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants authorization to the Tribal Roads Department to go ahead and bid on the Black River bridge repair and blacktopping projects.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Roads Department is directed to present a timely request for a bid bond and performance bond to the Tribal Council when appropriate.

The foregoing resolution was on August 11, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
