

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the need and desire to provide long-term nursing home care on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation for the White Mountain Apache people has been established in the Tribal Specific Health Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Feasibility Study for such a nursing home indicates that facility remodeling costs would exceed \$500,000.00, and

WHEREAS, based on present demand, operational costs for such a facility would require a minimum subsidy of more than \$100,000.00 per year, and

WHEREAS, given the reduced federal funding outlook, the development and operational costs for such a facility would have to be borne by the Tribe, and


WHEREAS, the present cash flow situation of the Tribe does not permit expenditures of this magnitude for the development and operation of a Nursing Home.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the findings of the Feasibility Study indicating that the development and operation of a Nursing Home on the reservation would presently be a financial burden on the Tribe are accepted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the establishment of a Nursing Home on the reservation is reaffirmed as a long-term goal of the Tribe; and, that the Tribe will continue to explore funding sources and funding alternatives to diminish the projections of the Feasibility Study and eventually establish a Tribal Nursing Home.

The foregoing resolution was on August 11, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
