WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe wishes to practice sound Game management techniques, and


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Game and Fish Department, after many hours of work and investigation, has determined that the area of north of McNary in Hunt Unit #1 has too many elk hunters in a small area, and

WHEREAS, if this intense hunting pressure continues it could seriously affect this northern elk herd.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the Game and Fish Department's plan for separate hunt units for the 1982 Tribal Member Elk hunt as per the attached sheets.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the attached hunting seasons and season dates be approved as listed.


The foregoing resolution was on August 13, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f & i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
