

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Head Start Program is operated by the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, one of the matching inkind resources is the Head Start Educational Facility, a tribal building, which has a deteriorated roof which constitutes a health and safety hazard to the children of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and


WHEREAS, repairs of the remaining two thirds (2/3) of the roof of the Head Start Building is estimated to cost \$13,900.00.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the expenditure of \$13,900.00 from Revenue Sharing funds for emergency purposes to protect the welfare of the White Mountain Apache children and property of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on September 08, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
