



RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mr. Archie Kinney and Miss Celine Avon Kinney, brother and sister, both to be known 1/2 degree of White Mountain Apache blood and 1/2 degree of Navajo blood were previously enrolled members of the Navajo Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, Archie Kinney and Celine Avon Kinney have presented applications for enrollment to the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, both applicants have executed proper documents with the Navajo Tribe relinquishing their rights on a voluntary basis, and
- WHEREAS, according to the Constitution and By-Laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, both applicants, Archie and Celine Avon Kinney are eligible and meet the requirements for enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Archie Kinney and Celine Avon Kinney are hereby approved for enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe and that their names will be added to the census rolls as of the date of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on September 08, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article III, Section 1 (c, d, & Sec. 2) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
