RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 82-225 the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe directs all Central Tribe (01) Department Managers to immediately implement and endorce the prescribed budget reductions, and
- WHEREAS, said reduction will be for all competitive positions in Central Tribe Departments (01), and
- WHEREAS, in order to accomplish this budget reduction, it is necessary for all employees to reduce their work hours by 10% per pay period (4 hours per week or 8 hours per pay period), and
- WHEREAS, each program or department manager will be required to make and submit appropriate work schedules for all employees to accomplish this mandate and at the same time consideration must be made of the needs of the department and the operation of the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, due to insurance risks, each employee who is in a non-work status shall leave the work premises during non-pay status.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that all Central Tribe Managers (01) submit to the Administrative Manager by September 20, 1982, an appropriate work schedule for all employees in their respective departments.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all managers assure that all employees affected comply with this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on September 10, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
