RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 82-225, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has directed a substantial reduction in the FY 82/83 operating budget of the Central Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the programs operating as part of the "Fourteen (14) Account" are an integral part of Central Tribe operations, and
- WHEREAS, the 14-Account Programs (five in number) are projected to have a combined deficit of approximately \$250,000.00 in FY 82/83; said deficit becoming a direct drain on the Tribal Treasury, and
- WHEREAS, in order to reduce the overall Tribal budget, it is necessary to cut the expenses of the 14-Account Programs to the greatest possible extent:
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the following 14-Account Programs be reduced as indicated:
 - 1. Fort Apache Scout: Reduce total budget from \$69,079.00 to \$44,000.00; saving \$25,000.00
 - 2. Cibecue Athletic Program: Reduce total budget expense from \$38,175.00; saving \$12,592.00
 - 3. Tribal Swimming Pool: Close on September 18, 1982, for balance of FY 82/83; saving \$46,152.00
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Administrative Manager be directed to take the following actions:
 - 1. Review the status of the swimming pool operation prior to the 83/84 budget cycle to determine the feasibility of its continuation on a sound financial basis.
 - Study the feasibility of developing a solar energy system for the swimming pool that will substantially reduce the cost of energy.
 - 3. To pursue a vigorous program for improving the accountability and cost-effectiveness of the Whiteriver Athletic Program.
 - 4. Assist the Arts & Crafts Program in developing effective sales and distribution systems to improve its volume and profitability.

The foregoing resolution was on September 14, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
