- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized to expend funds from the tribal budget for membership dues, for travel and accommodation expenses for the alternate delegates listed to participate in the National Congress

of American Indians and to sign such documents as necessary for full participation by the White Mountain Apache Tribe in the National Congress of American Indians Convention.

The foregoing resolution was on September 23, 1982, duly adopted by a vote of $\underline{6}$ for and $\underline{0}$ against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (45 Stat. 984).
