

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Virgil Hinton, Sr. has personally appeared before the Tribal Council and has requested that the Tribal Council assign him a homesite at Hondah located north of the Trailer Park and described legally as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$; NW $\frac{1}{4}$; NW $\frac{1}{4}$, of Section 22 T8N,
R23E, Lot Contains less than A Acre;
200 feet by 200 feet.

, and

WHEREAS, Virgil Hinton, Sr. advised the Tribal Council that he is already living on the premises but that he desires Tribal Council approval, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes there is no reason why Mr. Hinton should not be assigned the homesite as he has requested.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a lot assignment for Virgil Hinton, Sr. at Hondah located north of the Trailer Park with a legal description as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$: NE $\frac{1}{4}$: NE $\frac{1}{4}$, of Section 22 T8N,
R23E, Lot contains less than A Acre;
200 feet by 200 feet.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it directs the Tribal Council Secretary to send a copy of this Resolution to the Tribal Land Board Director, Raymus Albert for his files.

The foregoing resolution was on November 03, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
