



RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mrs. Cora Clendon, a widow and a tribal member, has come before the Tribal Council and stated that her present home at Canyon Day is not adequate for her family and needs two additional rooms to become comfortable and adequate, but that she lacks the financial means to do it herself, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after some discussion with Mrs. Clendon concludes that her request is worthy and her request for two additional rooms is necessary, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council believes that the Save the Children Federation Program may have the financial resources to assist Mrs. Clendon, and
- WHEREAS, tribal member, Kenneth Cromwell, also being present at the time of Mrs. Clendon's request, also has presented himself before the Tribal Council and asked that the Tribal Council assist him by providing him a suitable dwelling as he is now being compelled to live with his mother and she lacks the necessary space for him; and the Tribal Council also has recommended to him that the Save the Children Federation Program might be able to assist him financially in his need for a suitable home at Canyon Day.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests the Director of the Save the Children Federation Program, to attempt to obtain funds in order to remodel the house of Mrs. Cora Clendon by adding two rooms to her house at Canyon Day and that the Director also allocate or attempt to obtain funds for a suitable dwelling for tribal member, Kenneth Cromwell at Canyon Day.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby requests that the Director of the Save the Children Federation Program, Mrs. Charlotte Bahlen, report directly to the Tribal Chairman within twenty (20) days of the receipt of this resolution as to her efforts to obtain financial assistance to remodel the house of Mrs. Cora Clendon and to provide a suitable dwelling for Kenneth Cromwell, both of Canyon Day.

The foregoing resolution was on November 03, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
