

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Councilwoman, Mrs. Judy Dehose of Cibecue Community, has requested a Tribal Resolution approving a request from her constituents to have \$5,000.00 of the Land Claims Recreation money to be spent as follows:

- (1) \$1500.00 for outdoor field trip, and
- (2) \$3500.00 to make repairs on the old Community Building,

and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that the Cibecue Day School does not have the money to fund such a trip and that Mr. Richard Fisher, the Physical Education Instructor, would like to take some Junior High School students on an outdoor trip if money is available, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that a majority of the parents of children under the age of 18, fifty (50) names in all, have by their signatures that are attached to this resolution, have agreed that \$5,000.00 from the Land Claims Recreation money can be spent as specified above, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that their request is worthy.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request of the parents of the children of the Cibecue Day School to expend \$5,000.00 of the Land Claims Recreation money as follows:


- (1) \$1500.00 for outdoor field trip;

The foregoing resolution was on November 04, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
