RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs sponsors an Annual National Indian Timber Symposium for the purpose of exchanging and updating valuable information about the management of Indian forests and timber sales, and
- WHEREAS, the timbered tribes have formed the National Indian Tribal Timber Council to act as a formal body to disseminate information relative to Indian forests and to conduct the Annual Timber Symposium, and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has recognized the Inter-Tribal Timber Council as a formal body to review forestry programs with the Bureau and to make recommendations for their improvement, and
- WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Timber Council has successfully conducted the Annual Timber Symposium for the past six (6) years.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Council supports the contracting under P.L. 93-638 of the planning, conduct and publishing of National Indian Timber Symposium dissemination of information and provision of a forum for review of Bureau of Indian Affairs and Tribal forestry programs to the Inter-Tribal Timber Council on behalf of participating tribes.

The foregoing resolution was on November 09, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
