

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Indian Health Service P.L. 93-638 funding has been approved in the Tribal Health Authority contract for the lease of a used ambulance, and

WHEREAS, there is a demonstrable need for an additional ambulance to ensure adequate backup response for Emergency Medical Services, and

WHEREAS, if the Tribe acts as the lessor in a lease-purchase arrangement, the Tribe will be able to retain the ambulance at the completion of the lease, and

WHEREAS, there will be no impact on the cash flow of the Tribe as a result of the lease-purchase arrangement.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mr. Don Booker is authorized to enter into a lease-purchase agreement to procure the needed ambulance and to in turn lease the vehicle to the Tribal Health Authority Emergency Medical Services Program.


