WHEREAS, the assignment of Manley Begay as a Community Education Intern with the Tribal Education Program will enhance the community education services on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and


WHEREAS, the services of this intern will be provided at no cost to the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, this assignment is to the mutual benefit of both the Tribe and the intern.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it as the Cooperating Agency, approves the Memorandum of Agreement to assign Manley Begay as a Community Education Intern to the Tribal Education Program.

The foregoing resolution was on November 09, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
