

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. Alex Montanez of the Indian Health Service has presented a film entitled, Jonathan Danford, to the Tribal Council as a gift to the Tribal Council and the people of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Montanez produced this film after considerable effort on his part working with Jonathan Danford and other tribal members in order to communicate to the young people of the reservation the serious consequences involved when a person becomes addicted to sniffing gasoline and other toxic substances, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised from various sources that this film has contributed to preventing, educating, and alleviating the problem of drug abuse on the reservation as a result of the film being shown to school children throughout the reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that Mr. Montanez produced this film through his own private efforts and money without federal government input; and therefore, he should be commended for his efforts and contributions beyond the scope of his required employment duties with the Indian Health Service.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby extends its great appreciation to Mr. Alex Montanez for his outstanding contribution to the alleviation of the drug abuse problem on the reservation as a result of his dramatic and educational film about a young tribal member, who unfortunately became inflicted with an addiction to the sniffing of gasoline and other toxic substances.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it extends its appreciation to Mr. Montanez for the generosity that he has shown for donating this film and the right of copyright to the White Mountain Apache Tribe.


