RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WIEREAS, Alex Montanez, Counselor for the Indian Health Service, has produced a film regarding Jonathan Danford, a tribal member, and Jonathan's struggle with his addiction to sniffing of toxic substances; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Tontanez has produced this film on his own time and through his own efforts for the purpose of educating the youth on the reservation as to the serious consequences that may occur as a result of sniffing glue and gasoline and other toxic products to a person's health, lifestyle, employment and educational opportunities, and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Montanez has expressed to the Tribal Council that he wishes to donate this film to the Tribe as a gift so that the Tribe can copyright the film and control its distribution, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the distribution of the film should be controlled by the Office of the Tribal Chairman, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council expresses deep appreciation for this gift and for the work that Mr. Montanez has contributed to the welfare of the youth of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Attorney to obtain a copyright of the Jonathan Danford film and to prepare legal papers evidencing receipt of the gift from Mr. Montanez.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it directs that the film be distributed and controlled by the Office of the Tribal Chairman or a Tribal Agency designated by the Tribal Chairman.

The foregoing resolution was on December 01, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
