RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Gertie Lupe, on behalf of her daughter, Agatha Lupe, who is the present Reigning White Mountain Apache Tribel Queen, has come before the Tribal Council and has advised the Council that there is no money left in the Queen Budget Account for the queen to travel and to attend activities required by her title, and
- WHEREAS, Gertie Lupe explains to the Tribal Council that the Queen Committee has far exceeded its budget leaving no money whatsoever for Agatha Lupe to attend to her duties as a White Mountain Apache Tribal Queen, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after considerable discussion, concludes that the Tribal Queen, being a representative of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, should be provided with financial assistance so that she can properly attend State, National and Special events required by her position for the remaining period of her reign, and
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it can best support Queen Agatha Lupe by transferring certain line items in the budget account for Tribal Queen Expenses from Contingency Account No. 01-09-7906 to Queen Account No. 01-09-7907 within the present Tribal Budget so that further appropriations are not necessary and by directing the Tribal Chairman to monitor all expenditures for travelling by the Queen by conditioning all travel and other expenses to his prior approval.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the amount not to exceed \$800.00 be transferred from Contingency Account No. 01-09-7906 to Queen Account No. 01-09-7907 for the above purpose.

The foregoing resolution was on December 02, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
