

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, tribal member, Mrs. Grace Paxson of Canyon Day has come before the Tribal Council with a request for financial assistance for purposes of enlarging her present home in Canyon Day on the grounds that she has two children living with her and her present home is overcrowded and therefore, needs an addition to the house in order to accommodate everyone comfortably, and

WHEREAS, she further advised the Tribal Council that she has applied to the Save the Children Federation Program for assistance for this purpose, but that she has not received any such assistance to date, and

WHEREAS, the Director of Save the Children Federation Program being present states that Mrs. Paxson is still on the list for SCF Assistance which is contingent upon the availability of funds, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Mrs. Paxson's request is justified and that the Housing Improvement Program proceed to provide her with assistance according to the availability of funds and other criteria which they apply in determining priority of financial assistance.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Director of the Home Improvement Program to place Grace Paxson's name on the list of persons who are in line to receive assistance under the Home Improvement Program.


