


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council pursuant to a prior resolution directed the Tribal Attorney to amend the Exclusion and Removal Ordinance No. 128, in order to carry out the directives of said prior Resolution No. 82-289, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney has drafted said ordinance pursuant to guidelines set forth by the Tribal Council and the Tribal Council's Secretary has caused said ordinance to be posted in all public places for public comment for the required constitutional period of ten (10) days, and
- WHEREAS, said ten (10) days has transpired and no objections have been made to final passage of the Exclusion and Removal Ordinance as amended, a copy of which is attached to this Resolution as if set forth herein in full.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants final approval and enacts, effective immediately Ordinance No. 129as amended in the form and manner as attached hereto.


The foregoing resolution was on January 07, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (q) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
