


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the FY 1982/83 Capital Budget of the White Mountain Apache Agriculture Enterprise (WMAAE) provides approximately \$124,000.00 for purchase of equipment; of this amount, only \$7,500.00 has so far been expended, and
- WHEREAS, WMAAE has a very urgent need for additional equipment before the start of the 1983 crop season, and
- WHEREAS, because of the on-going national recession in the farm industry there is available a large selection of top-quality farm equipment priced at about 30¢ on the dollar of real value.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the General Manager of WMAAE is hereby authorized to expend up to \$34,350.00 from the WMAAE Capital Budget to acquire farm equipment as detailed on the list attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference; said estimated costs to include delivery on Reservation.


The foregoing resolution was on January 18, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 981)
