RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is the Governing Body of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to contract the Cibecue Day School, Cibecue, Arizona, and
- WHEREAS, the vehicle for the contract will be under the P. L. 93-638 and P. L. 95-561 for the tribe to enter into a contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs to include the following:

Transfer to the Tribe of the entire school operation, school administration, maintenance and operation and all facilities for education and living quarters, and

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council authorizes the Tribal Chairman to negotiate and execute the contract and amendments thereto, necessary to accomplish the transfer.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby sanctions the effort of the local school board as the agent to develop the P. L. 93-638 contract for submission to the proper Bureau of Indian Affairs Agency and Central Office for approval.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Education Department be authorized to act as the interim office to assist the school board members in developing the necessary P. L. 93-638 documents for the Tribal Chairman's signature and all other documents necessary to consumate the said Cibecue Day School contract, and any amendments thereto.

The foregoing resolution was on March 24, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
