RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mr. David Kinney, known to be 1/2 degree of White Mountain Apache blood and 1/2 degree of Navajo blood was previously enrolled member of the Navajo Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, David Kinney has presented application for enrollment to the Tribal Council of the Wnite Mountain Apache Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, David Kinney had executed proper documents with the Navajo Tribe relinquishing his rights with the Navajo Tribe on a voluntary basis, and
- WHEREAS, according to the Constitution and By-Laws of the White Mountain Apache Iribe, David Kinney is eligible and meets the requirements for enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the white Mountain Apache Tribe that David Kinney's request for enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe is hereby approved; and that David Kinney's name be added to the census rolls of the White Mountain Apache Iribe as of the date of this Resolution.

the toregoing resolution was on February 03, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Iribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section I (c, d, & sec. 2) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Iribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
