

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mrs. Virginia (Chissay) Declay, a tribal member and a Senior Citizen, has come before the Tribal Council with a request that the Council provide her with a comfortable, decent dwelling, and

WHEREAS, she further claims that five years ago she requested a house, but had never been provided with one, but was referred to the weatherization program where she was advised she was not eligible, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that her request is justified and that the Home Improvement Program put her on the waiting list for a comfortable home.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Home Improvement Program Director place Mrs. Virginia (Chissay) Declay on the waiting list in accordance with the greatest need and do all that is possible with available funding to provide Mrs. Declay with a decent dwelling.

The foregoing resolution was on March 02, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mounain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
