- WHEREAS, Wilbert and Norma (Endfreday Agent) poseph and Leta (Malker) Henry require a homesite lease, and
- WHEREAS, a homesite lease is required by Section 21 (e) (2) of the Declaration of Policies and Plan of Operation approved July 22, 1975, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has no objection to the lessee mortgaging the leasehold improvetable to the White Mountain Apache Tribe Revolving Gredit Program.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it hereby approves and grants homesize leases
 to Wilbert and Norma (Endfield) Albert, Joseph and Leta
 (Walker) Henry for a period of twenty-five (25) years with
 an option for an additional term of twenty-five (25) years
 at the rate of \$1.00 for twenty-five (25) years, payable
 in advance on the first day of the month following the
- BE True INVED that the Tribal Chairman shall execute said lease for and on behalf of the Morn win Trache Tribe in accordance with Tribal tracked to No. 44; the effective date of the commencement of said lease being the date of the approval of the loan by the Secretary of the Interior or his designated representative.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should an assignment have been made on the lot which is hereby leased, who lease don't nutomatically cancel the Assignment.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman shall approve the leasehold mortgage mortgaging the improvements to the White Mountain Apache Tribe Revolving Credit Program.
- BE 'TT FURTHER RESOLVED that should the loan not be approved within one hundred eighty (180) days from the date hereof, the lease and approval of the to mortgage the leasehold improvements shall thereby automatically terminate.
- The foregoing resolution was on March 02, 1983 duly adopted by a rose of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V. Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified at the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Sec ion 16 of the Act of June 18, 1974 (48 Stat. 984).
