RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mrs. Noddy (Early) Tortice approached the Tribal Council requesting assistance of the Council for a house, and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Tortice is a tribal member and does not presently have any type of a dwelling, but boarding with relatives on the reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that Mrs. Tortice is in dire need of a home for herself and her request is justified.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mrs. Noddy (Early) Tortice's name be placed on the housing list for the needy under any available program for the elderly and senior citizens.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Home Improvement Program, the TWEP and Weatherization Program and the Save the Children Federation Program be contacted as soon as possible for the request made by Mrs. Noddy (Early) Tortice.

The foregoing resolution was on March 03, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
