

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has formerly adopted Resolution No. 82-109, which authorized the Tribal Social Service Evaluation and Planning Project period from September 1, 1982 to extend for a period of one year; and

WHEREAS, two of the Human Service Center staff's salaries and related non-personnel cost categories derived from the approved grant of \$33,875.00 will be depleted by April, 1983; and

WHEREAS, Phase III of the project is to begin on March 3, 1983 through September 30, 1983; and

WHEREAS, the Human Service Center Director has submitted a proposal of \$20,249.00 at an official Revenue Sharing meeting in the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council Chambers on February 23, 1983; and

WHEREAS, the use of Revenue Sharing funds meets all of the criteria and would expedite the evaluation and planning project to a successful completion.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that \$20,249.00 of the Revenue Sharing Funds be appropriated to the Tribal Social Service Evaluation and Planning Project for personnel salaries, fringe benefits and for related non-personnel related costs.

The foregoing resolution was on March 03, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
