

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been invited by the Department of Housing and Urban Development to submit an application for a grant to fund certain eligible Indian Community Development Block Grant Program activities, and

WHEREAS, a meeting was held on February 9, 1983 for the purpose of soliciting project ideas for the Fiscal Year 1983 funding round, and

WHEREAS, the activities most likely to be funded under the approved rating system, in order to Tribal priority are:

1. A cattle feedlot facility to be operated by the White Mountain Apache Agriculture Enterprise as a component of the Canyon Day Irrigation Project;
2. A solid waste treatment facility.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the projects identified be developed and presented in draft form to HUD officials on March 18, 1983 for comment and application assistance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council will render final application approval at the Regular April Meeting, prior to submission of the application to HUD by April 11, 1983.

The foregoing resolution was on March 03, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
