


RESOLUTION OF THE

WHEREAS, due to the illness of the Tribal Council Secretary, Mrs. Mary C. Endfield, Resolution No. 83-98, duly passed March 24, 1983, was not signed by the Tribal Council Secretary within the ten-day time period to deliver said resolution to the Bureau of Indian Affairs Office; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney advises that a walk-through resolution is necessary to reapprove Resolution No. 83-98, having been signed by Acting Council Secretary of the Tribal Council.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms the adoption of Resolution No. 83-98, duly passed March 24, 1983, by a vote of nine (9) for and zero (0) against.

The foregoing resolution was on April 13, 1983, duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

The Tribal Attorney advises that a walk-through resolution is necessary to reapprove the attached resolution, having been signed by Acting Secretary of the Tribal Council.


