

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Professor J. Jefferson Reid, Associate Professor at the University of Arizona, Department of Anthropology, has come before the Tribal Council with a request to renew the digging permit for the Arizona Archaeological Field School at Grasshopper, and

WHEREAS, Professor Reid has exhibited, to the Tribal Council, a map designating the area whiche he is requesting for digging purposes which has been outlined by Professor Reid by a yellow line, and

WHEREAS, the area requested by Professor Reid constitutes a smaller area than that granted by the original digging permit, and

WHEREAS, the particulars of the exterior boundaries of the digging permit request must be described in greater detail so that there is no misunderstanding as to the limits within which digging by the University of Arizona Archaeological Field School may take place.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Professor Reid for the renewal of the digging permit on the condition that Professor Reid deliver a copy of a map outlining in yellow, that area in which the digging will take place, and upon the condition that he meet with the Tribal Attorney and Raymus Albert to more particularly describe the perimeter of the permissible digging area so that the same can be incorporated into a new digging permit to be executed by the Tribe and Bureau of Indian Affairs.




BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the digging permit shall expire three years from the time it is executed by and between all the parties.
