RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Bud Mast, the Bureau of Indian Affairs Forester and Acting Superintendent for the Fort Apache Indian Agency has presented to the Tribal Council a proposed cutting schedule for timber on the reservation which conforms to the five-year timber program and the annual allowable cut of 93 MMBM (84.3 MMBM Pine), and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has presented a cutting schedule for new timber sales from 1983 thru 1987, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference to this resolution, and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs Branch of Forestry requests authorization from the Tribal Council to proceed with the cruising and necessary contract documents to prepare the attached areas for sale to the Fort Apache Timber Company, and
- WHEREAS, after some discussion, the Tribal Council is in agreement with the proposed cutting schedule attached hereto.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Bureau of Indian Affairs Branch of Forestry to proceed with the cruising and necessary contract documents to prepare the attached areas for sale to the Fort Apache Timber Company.

The foregoing resolution was on June 01, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal-Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
