RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, by a prior resolution, the Tribal Council directed that the proposed abandoned vehicles ordinance be posted for the constitutionally required ten (10) days for purposes of inviting public comment prior to final passage, and
- WHEREAS, the Abandoned Vehicles Ordinance has been posted for the required ten (10) days and there has been no public comment received regarding modification of the proposed Abandoned Vehicles Ordinance, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the Abandoned Vehicles Ordinance as proposed and posted should be finally passed by the Tribal Council and be made effective law immediately.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby enacts the Abandoned Vehicles Ordinance No. 133 on this date to be effective immediately.
- BE IT FURIHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it directs that the Tribal Council Secretary prepare a final version and draft of the ordinance and distribute it to the appropriate tribal officials, including, but not limited to the Police Department, Tribal Court House, Boundary Patrol and all Tribal Enterprises.

The foregoing resolution was on June 01, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i, f, & q) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
