

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Continental Telephone Company of the West through its OSP Engineer, Larry M. Lunt, has advised the Tribal Attorney, who in turn has advised the Tribal Council that Contel plans to improve the telephone service for the Sunrise Ski Resort Area by placing telephone cable on Navopache Electric's existing pole lines with the exception of approximately 1200 feet which will be buried cable, and

WHEREAS, Continental Telephone Company requests that the Tribal Council grant it permission to bury the cable in the area designated by a Contel Right-of-Way drawing dated June 13, 1983 and designated as drawing or Job Order Number Contel No. B 4213-01, which has been shown to the Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that the proposed route for cable installation on Navopache Electric's existing pole lines and the buried cable along Highway 273 will benefit the people of the White Mountain Apache Tribe by enhancing the quality of telephone service in the Sunrise Ski Area, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that permission should be granted to install the cable as proposed.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to Continental Telephone Company to construct and install telephone cable lines along the proposed route as diagramed on Contel drawing Job Order No. B 4213-01.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby grants permission to Continental Telephone Company to bury telephone lines and therefor be granted a digging permit along the proposed route designated on the Contel diagram as Detail "A".


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby requires that Continental Telephone Company file a copy of the proposed route and any as-builts with the Tribal Utility Authority and the Bureau of Indian Affairs for reference purposes.

The foregoing resolution was on June 15, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
