

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has requested assistance from the Indian Health Service for the installation of sanitation facilities for 34 units of Tribal Housing in a project proposal dated January 10, 1983, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Utility Authority has adopted a resolution approving the attached Memorandum of Agreement, and
- WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service has requested an agreement by and between the Indian Health Service and White Mountain Apache Tribe and White Mountain Apache Utility Authority, such agreement having been proposed to the Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council having reviewed and considered the provisions of said agreement, including the project summary incorporated therein.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman is hereby authorized to execute the agreement for the construction of domestic water supply and sewage disposal facilities for Indian homes in the communities throughout the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on July 13, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
