

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Transportation has plans to replace the McCoy Bridge on the Hawley Lake Road, and


WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Transportation is in need of materials for construction of the new bridge, and has requested a permit for the said materials, and

WHEREAS, on August 4, 1967, the White Mountain Apache Tribe entered into an Agreement with the Arizona Highway Department whereby the State would provide improvements and maintenance of the Hawley Lake Road, and


WHEREAS, in this Agreement, the Tribe agreed to provide earthen materials without cost to the State for any future construction, reconstruction or realignment of the Hawley Lake Road.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman and the Superintendent are hereby authorized to issue a non-exclusive permit without cost to the Arizona Department of Transportation for sand and Gravel materials to be used on the project, Pit No. M.S. 1547A and Haul Road 1 as shown on the plat attached to said permit.

The foregoing resolution was on July 13, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
