

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by a previous Resolution No. 82-253, directed that the Bureau of Indian Affairs Area Office remove or transfer Superintendent Henry A. Dodge from the position with the Fort Apache Indian Agency for reasons enumerated in said resolution, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after discussion regarding that previous resolution, now concludes that said resolution should be rescinded as it pertains to Henry A. Dodge, with the remaining portions of the resolution regarding Fred Chavez to remain in full force and effect.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby rescinds Resolution No. 82-253 to the extent that it refers to Henry A. Dodge.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that any portion of the resolution which does not pertain to Henry A. Dodge shall remain in full force and effect.

The foregoing resolution was on July 14, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
