

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been invited by the Department of Housing and Urban Development to submit an application for a grant under P. L. 98-8 (Job's Bill), and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has satisfied and will continue to adhere to the requirements of 24 CFR 571.604 concerning citizen's participation, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that the Cibecue Regional Sewer System is a priority project for funding under this program, both to provide necessary basic community facilities and to provide jobs in a high-unemployment area of the reservation, and

WHEREAS, in connection with this application to HUD, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is required to make certain assurances hereinafter resolved:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:


1. The Tribal Chairman is authorized to sign documents and otherwise act to submit an application and complete a grant agreement with HUD.
2. That to the best of its knowledge and ability, the reservation population and poverty level data submitted are accurate and represent the best available data.
3. That to the extent practicable, it will utilize funds awarded under the Jobs Program in a manner which maximizes immediate creation of new employment opportunities to individuals who were unemployed at least fifteen (15) weeks of the last twenty-six (26) weeks immediately preceding March 24, 1983.
4. That Job's Bill funds will be obligated and disbursed as rapidly as possible so as to quickly assist the unemployed and needy.

The foregoing resolution was on July 14, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
