

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, K.N.N.B. Apache Radio Station is extending its broadcast area by installing four (4) translators at Cibecue Mountain, Carrizo, Cedar Creek and Kinney Mountain to include the communities in those areas which have not been receiving radio signal, and

WHEREAS, each community site has required the construction of a shed to house translator equipment at a cost of \$1,000.00 per shed, and

WHEREAS, the Vocational Skill Center has completed the construction of all four (4) sheds at a total cost of \$4,150.00.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves payment for the completed construction of the four (4) translator sheds from Account #W-186, White Mountain Apache Tribe 22-D (Western Apache Claims Community Development), which is on deposit in the United States Treasury.


The foregoing resolution was on July 19, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
