. RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Sarah Massey, a tribal member, 85 years of age, has requested housing assistance from the Tribal Council on the grounds that her present house contains no heating and cannot be repaired and is unsuitable for her to live in by herself, and
- WHERFAS, further, the Tribal Council is advised that Sarah Massey is a widow who has been forced to support herself without the benefit of a husband for many years, and therefore, has been unable to afford a home but has been forced due to her circumstances, to live in a house for over twenty-five years without adequate heat, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Sarah Massey's needs are very great and that she is very deserving of a house from the Home Improvement Program.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby request the Home Improvement Program to place Sarah Massey on the pricrity list for a home and that a home should be provided to her as soon as possible.

The foregoing resolution was on August 03, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V. Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 79, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
