

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mrs. Alice (Cromwell) Ethelbah, a tribal member, has come before the Tribal Council with a request to be included in the Home Improvement Program housing program in order that she can be given a decent dwelling and in support of her request advises the Tribal Council that her husband is disabled and unable to work, that she is being evicted from her FHA home for failure to make house payments but that because of the disability of her husband, she cannot make the home payments, but; nevertheless, needs a decent home for her and her husband as they have no place to go after they are evicted, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees with Mrs. Ethelbah's request and concludes that she has established a great need for a home through the Home Improvement Program.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Home Improvement Program Housing Program to place Mrs. Alice (Cromwell) Ethelbah and her husband on their list for a Home Improvement Program house.

The foregoing resolution was on August 03, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
