

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. McCormick of the McCormick Trucking Company, Phoenix, Arizona, contractor for the demolition of several Bureau of Indian Affairs buildings on the reservation has come before the Tribal Council with a request to utilize the Whiteriver City Dump for purposes of dumping cement and other debris resulting from the demolition of the buildings, and

WHEREAS, Mr. McCormick has a tentative agreement with the Tribal Work Experience Program directed by Adam Lupe, to give Tribal Work Experience Program the salvage rights to the Bureau of Indian Affairs Club House for \$1.00 and also to donate \$2,000.00 to Tribal Work Experience Program for purposes of paying the Tribal Work Experience Program workers to tear down the Bureau of Indian Affairs Club House as consideration for being allowed to use the Whiteriver City Dump, and

WHEREAS, further, pursuant to Tribal Council requirements, Mr. McCormick will post a cash bond to guarantee his cleanup of the Whiteriver City Dump after he has completed his demolition of the Bureau of Indian Affairs buildings, and

WHEREAS, Mr. McCormick in consideration for the use of the Whiteriver City Dump has also agreed to transport by his trucks, concrete to areas along the North Fork of the Whiteriver to be used as rip-rap to prevent erosion, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney is hereby directed to meet with Adam Lupe and Mr. McCormick to work out the details of the agreement discussed above.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Attorney to draft an agreement with Mr. McCormick and Tribal Work Experience Program and to incorporate the provisions set forth above into said agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that said agreement shall terminate upon completion of the Bureau of Indian Affairs contract by Mr. McCormick for the demolition of the Bureau of Indian Affairs buildings.

The foregoing resolution was on August 03, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to its authority vested in Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
