

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Office of the Vice-Chairman is responsible for coordination and oversight of a variety of projects and activities as assigned by the Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, these responsibilities require considerable staff time for proper management, and


WHEREAS, in recognition of this situation, the Tribal Council has provided approximately 50% funding of an Administrative Assistant Position for the Tribal Vice-Chairman's Office from Tribal revenues.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a P.L. 93-638 Grant application be submitted to the Bureau of Indian Affairs for approximately \$10,500.00 of FY 84 P.L. 93-638 grant funds to provide the remaining funds required for the position of Administrative Assistant in the Office of the Vice-Chairman.

The foregoing resolution was on August 03, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
