RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is concerned with sound game management on the reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the I. D. Game Reserve was created for purposes of game management, and
- WHEREAS, after extensive aerial surveys and ground transects, it has been determined that the Game refuge may now be reopened, and
- WHEREAS, the opening of the area to hunting will not harm the wildlife populations currently inhabiting the Reserve.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that as of August Ol, 1983, the area now called the I. D. Game Reserve will be open to hunting for both Small Game and Big Game species during their designated seasons.

The foregoing resolution was on August 03, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f,h, & i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
