WHEREAS, Mr. Moran Mark, a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, has constantly contacted the Tribal Census Office requesting that he be allowed to relinquish his membership and headrights with the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Mark is an adult and voluntarily making this decision to enroll with the Navajo Tribe with identification on the official census rolls of the White Mountain Apache Tribe as follows:

WHEREAS, the parents are agreeable to the relinquishment of their son's rights from the White Mountain Apache Ttibe inorder to enroll with the Navajo Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mr. Moran Mark is hereby released from the Official Census Rolls of the White Mountain Apache Tribe inorder to enroll with the Navajo Tribe as of the date of this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the request of Mr. Moran Mark for relinquishment of his tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe had been completed on a boluntary basis and a copy of the document is hereby attached.

The foregoing resolution was on September 07, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and Article III, Section 3 of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
