

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. Moran Mark, a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, has constantly contacted the Tribal Census Office requesting that he be allowed to relinquish his membership and headrights with the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Mark is an adult and voluntarily making this decision to enroll with the Navajo Tribe with identification on the official census rolls of the White Mountain Apache Tribe as follows:

NAME: MORAN MARK  
SEX: MALE  
DATE OF BIRTH: MAY 16, 1962  
SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER: 527-45-0027  
FAM.ROLL NO. 02062  
DEGREE OF INDIAN BLOOD: 1/2 White Mountain Apache Indian  
1/2 Navajo Indian  
FATHER: Thomas Kee Mark - 4/4 Navajo Indian enrolled with the Navajo Tribe.  
MOTHER: Fern (Johnson) Mark - 4/4 White Mountain Apache Indian enrolled with the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Mark has further voluntarily and properly executed the necessary documents to accomplish said relinquishment, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Moran Mark does not have any property, land or funds with the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the parents are agreeable to the relinquishment of their son's rights from the White Mountain Apache Tribe in order to enroll with the Navajo Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mr. Moran Mark is hereby released from the Official Census Rolls of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in order to enroll with the Navajo Tribe as of the date of this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the request of Mr. Moran Mark for relinquishment of his tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe had been completed on a voluntary basis and a copy of the document is hereby attached.


The foregoing resolution was on September 07, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and Article III, Section 3 of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

I, MORAN MARK, an enrolled member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, Fort Apache Indian Reservation, Whiteriver, Arizona, SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER 527-45-0027, DATE OF BIRTH: May 16, 1962; DEGREE OF BLOOD: 1/2 White Mountain Apache and 1/2 Navajo Indian; PARENTS: Thomas Kee Mark, Navajo and Fern (Johnson) Mark, White Mountain Apache, would like to voluntarily relinquish my headrights to which I am entitled to by reason of my birth, relationship, enrollment and/or other reasons that entitles me to claim any rights, title or interest as a member of any other Indian Tribe or Band of Indians.

I realize that hereafter I will not have any home or farmland assignment, no fishing and hunting privileges, nor livestock or claims to any resources of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and reservation. I have made this decision on my own.
