

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. Bill Amos of the Bureau of Indian Affairs Roads Department has come before the Tribal Council regarding Resolution No. 82-294 which establishes and itemizes road construction priorities and projects on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 82-294 states that "the priorities may be changed at any time by the committee and/or the Tribal Council", and

WHEREAS, Mr. Amos has requested that the priorities be changed annually rather than "at any time" so that the Roads Department and committees can have sufficient lead time so that they can plan their budgets and allocations of material, equipment and manpower accordingly, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees with Mr. Amos that the priorities should be set annually and that Resolution No. 82-294 should be amended with the proviso that priorities may be changed annually by the committees and/or the Tribal Council, but that the remainder of Resolution No. 82-294 shall remain in full force and effect.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby amends Resolution No. 82-294 by changing the 4th WHEREAS sentence which states, "the priorities may be changed any any time by the committees and/or the Tribal Council", to the following language, "the priorities may be changed annually by the committees and/or the Tribal Council".


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the remainder of Resolution No. 82-294 shall remain in full force and effect until further amendment by the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on September 07, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


