

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by previous resolution directed that the Tribal Attorney amend the Exclusion and Removal Ordinance for purposes of strengthening the ordinance and for purposes of further defining acts and conduct engaged in by Federal Officials which would constitute a violation of said Ordinance, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said instruction, the Tribal Attorney drafted such an amendment which has been posted for the ten days required by the Tribal Constitution and By-Laws for public comment, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that final passage of the amendment is necessary for the protection of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and is in the public interest of the people of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby enacts Ordinance No.139 amendment Ordinance No. 129 otherwise known as the Exclusion and Removal Ordinance, said amendment to be effective immediately.


The foregoing Resolution was on October 19, 1983 adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i & q) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
