

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after full discussion regarding the Tribal Travel Policy, has concluded that the governmental and executive functions of the Tribal Council, Chairman's Office, Vice-Chairman's Office, Office of the Tribal Council Secretary, Tribal Attorney's Office and Tribal Treasurer should be exempted from the Tribal Travel Policy provisions pertaining to finances, itemization for reimbursement and the like due to the nature of their duties and responsibilities which require expeditious travel arrangements, emergencies, and a minimal compensation which the existing travel regulations to some extent hinder, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council hereby concludes that the following per diem shall be paid for the above-named persons as follows:

1. In-State travel, \$50.00 per day for room and board (per diem);
2. Out-of-State travel in a nonhigh cost area, \$75.00 per diem;
3. \$100.00 per day for high-cost areas previously identified by the Tribal Travel Regulations, and

WHEREAS, all travel regulations shall remain in full force and effect except as otherwise exempted herein.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby modifies the Tribal Travel Regulations as applied to the Office of the Tribal Chairman and staff; Office of the Vice-Chairman and staff; Tribal Council Members, Tribal Council Secretary, Tribal Treasurer and Tribal Attorney and staff.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the aforementioned Executive Officers shall receive effective immediately \$50.00 per diem for in-State travel on Tribal business; \$75.00 per diem for out-of-State travel in nonhigh cost areas and \$100.00 per diem for high-cost areas previously identified by the Tribal Travel Regulations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby reaffirms that all Tribal Travel Regulations shall remain in full force and effect except that otherwise specified herein in the existing travel regulation and praise the achievements of the Administrative Manager obtained to date through his implementation and enforcement of these travel regulations.

The foregoing resolution was on October 24, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
