RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that Kristy Sue Dunlap has applied for enrollment into the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, Kristy Sue Dunlap has been adopted by Mrs. Vera Dunlap who is the wife of Willie Dunlap; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that Kristy Sue Dunlap is 4/4 San Carlos Apache Indian and is the natural daughter of a relative of Mrs. Vera Dunlap; said relative being enrolled at San Carlos and moreover, Mrs. Vera Dunlap is still enrolled with the San Carlos Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, based on the foregoing facts, Kristy Sue Dunlap does not qualify for enrollment in the White Mountain Apache Tribe in accordance with the Constitution and By-Laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe because of lack of White Mountain Apache blood.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby declines to accept the enrollment of Kristy Sue Dunlap based upon the Constitution and By-Laws setting forth enrollment requirements of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on November 3, 1983, duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article III, Section 1 and 2 and Article V, Section 1 (a,s,t,u) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
